

## SHDF SCHEME PRIMA GROUP

We have been delivering a £4.7M whole house, fabric first range of insulation works in a combined SHDF (Wave 1 and 2) and planned works project to 155 homes for Prima across the North West.

The project aims were to improve the energy efficiency of the homes which currently have an energy performance (EPC) rated below SAP Band D, and the standard of kitchens and bathrooms.

We carried out a full turnkey service for this contract from Retrofit services, installation of all measures and Trustmark lodgement through our in-house compliance team.


- Employing a Cobalt resident as an apprentice on the project.

Ecogee will deliver energy efficiency works to 90 properties across Manchester.

We have been on site since February with works due to complete September 2025.

Working with Great Places Housing Group marks a milestone in our plans to establish ourselves in the Manchester region.

We're supporting Great Places to meet their ambitious target to upgrade 3,030 homes below an EPC C rating by 2030!

Our H&S team have also gained another homefrom-home as part of our office move. They have taken control over an additional unit at our head office in St Helens.

Our H&S hub provides a dedicated space for training including toolbox talks, mental health interventions, inductions and face fittings.

A MASSIVE thank you to our H&S team for keeping all our customers, staff and supply chain safe for another year and continually working with all our teams to ensure we are providing a 'safety first' approach on site.

Phase 2 of the refurbishment will begin later this year with a focus on the externals of the office.


